EDUCATION FOR DEMOCRATIC CITIZENSHIP : FROM POLICY TO EFFECTIVE PRACTICE THROUGH QUALITY ASSURANCE

(EDC-QA PROJECT)

Project presentation

Strategic goal and objectives :

The EDC-QA project is a Stability Pact (Enhanced Graz Process) and UNESCO project.

Its objective is to develop quality assurance systems for education for democratic citizenship in Southeast Europe.

The project strategy is to embed it within the ministries of education of Southeast European countries and to foster ministries' ownership of the project and of quality assurance development.

The project's assumption is to ensure the effectiveness of EDC practices in Southeast Europe by strengthening the processes of governance in education and by improving quality assurance development systems. Ultimately, quality assurance is to be incorporated into national educational policies.

Results and process

The project will produce an EDC specific QA instrument, organise training and pilots in the use of the instrument, and prepare national and regional QA guidelines for EDC.

The project recognizes that genuine local ownership of all of its dimensions is crucial to success. Therefore, central to the project is the aim to bring together the range of important actors and institutions who are key to success in developing and implementing effective EDC policies and practices.

In addition to ensuring the strong link with the ministries of education, the project is designed to involve together policymakers and leaders in education ministries, practitioners in formal education (headmasters, teachers, pupils), NGOs, researchers and experts in educational development and evaluation, both in national EDC QA teams and in a regional consortium.

Project plan

The project, taking place in 2003 - 2005, is planned to take place at three levels: regional, national and school. The project design is organized into three phases of research and development activities. It assumes that in a fourth phase, the new tools would be introduced in all schools and other relevant institutions within participating countries.

Phase 1 : laying the foundations – setting up of researchers' group; stocktaking study of existing international work; preparation of a EDC specific QA instrument; setting up of national EDC QA teams; setting up of regional consortium; regional seminar (exchange of experience and presentation of results);

Phase 2 : training and piloting - setting up (including the production of specific materials) and organisation of regional training course on the QA framework; organisation of national training courses; piloting the use of the QA framework;

Phase 3 : finalisation of the EDC QA instruments - review feedback from piloting activities; preparation of regional and national QA guidelines; preparation of project report; organisation of project final regional seminar.

Management

The project coordinating institution is the Centre for Educational Policy Studies (CEPS), University of Ljubljana. Support is provided by a co-coordinator and a technical assistant. A core group, involving experts from the coordinating institution, Croatia, Macedonia Romania and Scotland /UK as well as UNESCO, will manage the project. An on-going accompanying evaluation is carried out within the project.
